Mindo Cloud Forest

This excursion begins travel to the west area of Quito, towards the cloud forest on the Pichincha Volcano slopes, on the Northern Andes.

Our first stop will be in the Pululahua Reserve, where we can find the Pululahua volcano and its crater, one of the few active and inhabited volcanoes in the world. Here we can observe an impressive landscape, as well as flora and fauna characteristic of the Andes of Ecuador. Next, we will have an interesting stop in the Pahuma reserve where we will enjoy a simple walk through the forest where we can admire a magnificent sample of native orchids, waterfalls, rivers and primary forest.

We continue towards the city of Mindo and visit the butterfly farm, after which we will arrive at the beautiful bird area. We will have lunch and we will have the opportunity to observe several species of birds almost effortlessly: Hummingbirds, tanagers and even toucans: in the afternoon we will return to the city of Quito.
